1. **Location**
2. Queenstown is situated in the lower half of the South Island within the Southern Lakes region. The town is located on the shores of Lake Wakatipu. The permanent population of Queenstown is 29 000 that doubles during the summer and winter seasons.
3. **Flights.** It has just become a lot easier to reach the city with 19 flights per day and this includes direct flights from the following international airports:
 - a. Auckland
 - b. Christchurch
 - c. Wellington
 - d. Brisbane
 - e. Gold Coast

- f. Sydney
- g. Melbourne

4. **Road.** Driving from Christchurch to Queenstown is 487km and will take 7.15 hours to drive.
5. **Local Travel.** Queenstown Airport is situated 9km (15 min drive) from the town centre. Rental cars and taxis are accessible for local travel. A taxi from the airport to town centre will cost \$35.
6. **Conference Transport.** Providing 4 x 10 seater and 2 x VIP vehicle options for conference transport. Attendees will be picked up at airport on arrival. Transport will be available to the Skyline for the Formal Dinner.
