I refer to your email of 24 November 2023 requesting further information in relation to the response of 28 October 2023. Your request for the following has been considered in accordance with the Official Information Act 1982 (OIA):

Tekapo MC was included on the request but not referenced in the reply. Is that bc there are no contracts in place or if this part of the query has been declined?

I would also like some clarification around the PAE/Spotless contracts — there is a total of 6 contracts (three held by each provider), what the contracts cover in total, what provider services what camp/base, the duration of each contract, and the overall p.a. value, but it is not clear which bit of info relates to the which other bit so it's hard to understand on a contract-specific level what a given contract covers, who holds it and when it is due to expire...I would value some clarity on this part of the request if possible.

The New Zealand Defence Force contracts for hospitality and facility management services across camps and bases are assigned on a regional basis. Tekapo Military Camp is included in the facilities management contract for the Southern Region (generally referred to as the Burnham Contract). There is no contract for hospitality services at Tekapo Military Camp.

In relation to facility management contracts with PAE: the Contract for the Northern Region (Papakura Military Camp, Devonport Naval Base and RNZAF Whenuapai) expires in August 2025; the contract for the Wellington Region (Trentham Military Camp) expires in March 2025; and the contract for the Tasman Region (RNZAF Woodbourne) expires in December 2024.

In relation to facility management contracts with Spotless: the contract for the Central Region (Waiouru Military Camp, Linton Military Camp and RNZAF Ohakea) expires in July 2025; and the contract for the Southern Region (Burnham Military Camp and Tekapo Military Camp) expires in June 2025.

Further detail about the contracts between the NZDF and these service providers is withheld in accordance with section 9(2)(j) of the OIA.
