I refer to your email of 5 August 2024 requesting, under the Official Information Act 1982 (OIA), information on New Zealand Defence Force (NZDF) rental income.

- The amount of housing and accommodation rental income the New Zealand Defence Force made in 2021, 2022 and 2023
- As well as the projected rental and accommodation income for the full years 2024
- And 2025 projected income when the full rental and accommodation increases will take place

The NZDF does not record the rent received for housing and barracks separately. The table below provides the rent received in total for both housing and barracks from the 2020/21 financial year to the 2023/24 financial year, and the projected total for the 2024/25 financial year.

- A request for the breakdown of where the rental and accommodation income was spent and/or allocated in 2021, 2022 and 2023
- And where it is projected to be spent and allocated for 2024 and 2025.

The NZDF utilises rental revenue received to offset barrack and housing maintenance costs. The table below provides the maintenance and repair expenditure for Defence housing and barracks, where the figures are those attributed to building assets.

With respect to barracks, these costs do not include all aspects of maintenance and repair, such as routine scheduled maintenance and minor repairs, as these are not attributable to a specific building type and are not separable. Barrack maintenance is tracked as jobs are assigned; however, the expectation is the cost for the 2024/25 financial year will match previous years' allocation ratios.
