I refer to your letter of 21 August 2024 requesting, under the Official Information Act 1982 (OIA), details on information provided in the New Zealand Defence Force (NZDF) response *OIA-2024-5094-HCP-operational-expenses*.

1) What software and computer charges does HCP incur?

NZDF Heritage Commemorations and Protocol (HCP) software and computer charges are for the annual licences of software and the purchase of devices such as laptops and their associated peripherals.

- 2) What items have made up the freight and customs duty costs in the years set out? This is the necessary equipment for ceremonial activities in New Zealand and overseas.
  - 3) What items fall under "material and consumable"?

Food, clothing and ammunition required for ceremonial activities. Ammunition in this instance refers to that expended during gun salutes.

4) What does "other purchase service" mean? What items fall under this category? Can you please break down what costs have comprised the most recent two years' amounts?

These are wreaths and gifts purchased on behalf of the Chief of Defence Force for national and international commemorations. A breakdown of the costs in this category for the last two years is at Enclosure 1.

5) What are "professional services"? If this is catering for promotion ceremonies and similar, can you please set out for me in the years set out what the 10 highest-cost professional services amounts were for and what function or event they related to?

This is infrastructure support for the commemorations at Gallipoli and Chunuk Bair provided by an event management company and a foreign government agency. The company is selected through an international tender process. Anzac Day commemorations at Gallipoli are funded by New Zealand and Australia. The event is attended by many New Zealanders every year and broadcast back to New Zealand. Associated costs include: site security; stands; tenting; seating; waste; sanitation; lighting; sound; power generation; and site build.

6) What telecommunications does HCP undertake? What is that budget spent on? Telecommunications costs are the monthly subscriptions paid for One NZ and iPad contracts.

7) For the years set out, what are the travel destinations and how much was spent on each one?

The travel destinations and costs of the HCP group for the financial years ending 2020 to 2024 are broken down in the below table.
