On 6 September 2023 and 4 September 2024, the Director of Defence Health Policy provided relevant NZDF personnel and staff policy updates that included Defence Health Directive 23/003. The relevant extracts are at Enclosure 1.

• With reference to paragraph 12, the number of times Defence Health has been notified "of when an individual has been exposed to military weapons system hazard", broken down by originating unit and month;

- With reference to paragraph 22, the number of personnel who have exhibited "persistent deleterious cognitive effects that persist after 4 weeks of rest" who were "assessed for appropriate grading and potential permanent restrictions on activities", and the outcome of those assessments.
