I refer to your email of 19 February 2025 requesting, under the Official Information Act 1982 (OIA), the following information:

1. *Any strategy, annual reporting policy documentation, framework or assessment schedule that addresses and defines your agencies' progress measures in meeting your tasked outcomes and actions with specific regard to the NZCTVE strategy.*
2. *The assessment methodology your agency uses to measure your success, progress or gaps in meeting your tasked outcomes. Please include KPIs, quantitative data (metrics) and any qualitative measures of success/progress.*
3. *If your agency does not have any formal assessment measures, a brief explanation as to why your agency has chosen not to do so.*
4. *If your agency has a planned assessment framework which is currently under development, when this assessment is due to be released and whether it will be made available to the NZ Public.*

I understand that you made the same request to the Department of Prime Minister and Cabinet (DPMC) and DPMC has consulted with you and have provide you with the substantive response on the New Zealand Countering Terrorism and Violent Extremism (NZCTVE) Strategy.

Domestically, the New Zealand Defence Force (NZDF) acts in support of other central and/or local government agencies. There are no progress measures *with specific regard to the NZCTVE strategy*. The NZDF provides support in meeting Output 4.3 – Assistance to the Civil Power and Provision of a Public Service in Emergency Situations, and this is reported in NZDF Annual Reports that are publicly available on the NZDF website¹. For instance, information on the support provided in response to the Christchurch mosque attacks is available in the 2019 Annual Report.
